KILLEEN, Texas (<u>FOX 44</u>) — The Killeen Regional Airport held a ribbon-cutting ceremony at the CSI Aviation Hangar on Wednesday to celebrate a second hangar facility.

The new Corporate Hangar II is a state-of-the-art facility designed to support the growing of CSI Aviation. The goal for this facility is to support the aviation company by enhancing its maintenance, operational capabilities, and more.

"It's an expansion of a partnership that we started with CSI back in 2018," says City of Killeen Executive Director of Aviation Mike Wilson, referring to the city and CSI Aviation. "They started with one little small town hangar and a handful employees, and today they've had over 90 employees based here in Killeen. So it's a great day for the city. It's great day for the airport."

The hangar space will be 8,000 square feet, and there will be 4,000 square feet of office space separated onto two floors.

CSI Aviation pilot Jacob Nemec expressed his excitement for the hangar, "I'm feeling very excited. This company is growing very rapidly."

He also highlighted the importance of the new hangar in the City of Killeen, "I think it's important. It's right next to our main hangar here. This is our home base for the entire company. We do all of our maintenance out of here. Adding this extra hangar is going to aid us with maintenance, aircraft stability operations, flying missions. It's going to help CSI very much."
